



"Lakes & Fishing" in Pine County

Pine County has many more fishing lakes to be explored, we want you to have the opportunity to experience them all!

CROSS LAKE: Pine City

938 acres, public access on the north bank of Snake River as it enters lake and on the east side of the lake off of County Road 9. Fisheries present include muskie, walleye, northern pike, bluegills, white bass, larger mouth bass, white and black crappies, cat fish and sturgeon.

POKEGAMA LAKE: Pine City

1,536 acres, public access located on the south end of the lake off County Road 7. Connected to Cross Lake by the Snake River. Fisheries present include muskie, walleye, northern pike, bluegills, white bass, larger mouth bass, white and black crappies, cat fish and sturgeon.

BASS LAKE: Sandstone

189 acres, public access on west side of lake. Fisheries present include walleye, northern pike, black crappies, bluegill and large mouth bass.

GRINDSTONE LAKE: Sandstone

525 acres, Public access located north end of lake. Fisheries present include brown and rainbow trout, lake trout, northern pike, large and smallmouth bass, black crappies, bluegills, rock bass, smelt and herring.

LAKE ELEVEN: Sandstone

290 acres, public access on south end of lake. Fisheries present include walleye, northern pike, largemouth bass, black croppies and bluegills.

BIG PINE LAKE: Finlayson

387 acres, public access on north end of lake. Fisheries present include walleye, northern pike, largemouth bass, black crappies and bluegills.

UPPER PINE LAKE: Finlayson

Public access on north end. Fisheries present include northern pike, largemouth bass, black crappies, bluegill, yellow perch and bullhead.

ISLAND LAKE: Sturgeon Lake

547 acres, public access on southwest side of lake. Fisheries present include walleye, northern pike, largemouth bass, black crappies and bluegills.

SAND LAKE: Sturgeon Lake

501 acres, Public access on south end of lake. Fisheries present include walleye, northern pike, largemouth bass, black crappies, rock bass, white sucker and bluegills.

STURGEON LAKE:

1,456 acres, public access on the north end of lake. Fisheries present include largemouth bass, walleye, northern pike, black crappies, rock bass, white sucker and bluegills.

MOOSE LAKE:

125 acres, public access on west side of lake next to swimming beach. Fisheries present include bluegill, northern pike, crappies and sunfish.
